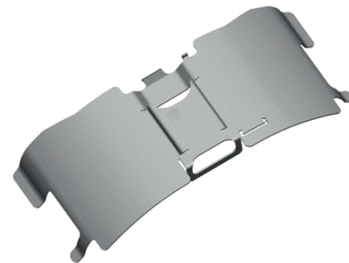




BPW running gear with ECO Disc TS2 3709 and offset 0 now with cover plate for the brake caliper lining shaft

From calendar week 33 / 2024, BPW will be equipping the single-tired 9 t and 10 t running gear with TS2 3709 and offset 0 with shaft cover plates as standard.



BPW is almost the only trailer running gear manufacturer who offers the disc brake with a hub with offset 0.

The advantage is a significant weight saving compared to an offset 120 version. In conjunction with the LightTube and the aluminum hub, BPW even has by far the lightest unit on the trailer market.

The disadvantage is that the brake is less protected by the wheel and the brake pads as well as the bellows of the tappet are directly exposed to dirt and water ingress and damage can occur more easily.

For a better protection of the brake pads on the TS2 3709 configuration with offset 0, BPW has now decided to use a shaft cover plate as standard for this version.

This applies to the 22.5" single tires with wheel connection 10/ 335 and the 19.5" single tires with wheel connection 8/ 275. Please note, however, that when used with 19.5" tires, the inner rim diameter must be greater than 436 mm.

A combination with brake pad wear sensing is possible.
